Student chromebooks were distributed to parents/guardians this summer. The chromebook was the student and parent's responsibility through the duration of the check-out period. Therefore, any misuse, loss, or damage will be the financial responsibility of the parent or guardian.

Many families who borrowed Chromebook devices from the school for Virtual Learning have inquired about how to return the devices.

As we move into the new school year, we wanted to provide you with the details about returning the device.

If you have a student who will not be returning to Shenandoah in August, please make arrangements to return the checkout Chromebook to the cart in the Shenandoah lobby.

These are students who will be attending middle school or a different elementary school for the 2020-2021 school year.

PROCEDURES FOR RETURNING THE DEVICE

Please read the following instructions on how to return the Chromebook to Shenandoah Elementary.

**Where: Shenandoah Elementary School Front Lobby
Shenandoah Chromebook Cart**

Procedures:

- Please bring the chromebook and charger to the Shenandoah's Front Lobby
- Please sign in the device on the clipboard to make checking in the device more convenient.
- You will receive a confirmation email when the device has been inspected and checked back into the system.
- You will be contacted if any damages were reported; a fine may be charged depending on the extent of the damage.
